Motion to accept the resignation of Jeneva Touchie as alternate director and accept the appointment of Gertrude Touchie as alternate director by the Yuuthluithaht Government effective June 2, 2023 passed by consensus.

5. Election of Officers- Executive Committee

Olga Nassinovskaia led the board in the executive committee election process. With a couple of board seats vacant, Rebecca suggested combining the secretary and treasurer position until the fall and new directors have been oriented.

Motion to appoint officers of the Society to hold the offices set out following their name (Naomi Mack – co-chair, Mike Davis- secretary-treasurer, Nicky Ling- co-chair) until the close of the next annual general meeting or until others are elected or appointed in their place passed by consensus.

6. Biosphere Research Award Recommendation

Rebecca provided an overview of the application review process and the 2023 Biosphere Research Award recommendation, as well as additional project support leveraged from partner businesses.

The two projects recommended are:

- a. Salmon Highways: Kelp Forest Habitat in Clayoquot Sound, \$20,000 request from Redd Fish Restoration Society
- b. Microplastic Ingestion by Humpback Whales in Barkley Sound, \$ 17,858 request from University of Victoria researcher Rhys Jenson

The committee recommended supporting both projects; the two projects are very different and will both be impactful. Staff recommended that they assist the UVic applicant with additional fundraising.

Motion to approve \$7,500 towards Redd Fish Restoration and \$12,500 to the University of Victoria project passed by consensus.

7. Community Foundations Canada conference update

A small team of staff attended the biennial conference along with Mike Davis as treasurer. Staff appreciated the practical sessions and opportunity to reconnect with colleagues post-pandemic. Mike highly recommended that board members take part in upcoming conferences. He was happy to share that we have an awesome team and are ahead of the curve on Vital Signs. Mike appreciated the board governance sessions and shared the importance of being aware of risks tied to cyber security and Al. He also was reminded of the importance of continuity and capacity building on the board given term limits. Rebecca and Mike also got the opportunity to meet potential fund managers and learn about processes other foundations have used to update investment portfolio statements.
