

Lima Action Plan for UNESCO's MAB programme and World Network of Biosphere Reserves 2016-2025

In 2016, delegates from UNESCO Biospheres around the world met in Lima, Peru, to create a list of actions that would achieve the MAB Strategy of 2015. The Lima Action Plan is divided into four areas of action.

Strategic Action Areas:

- A. The World Network of Biosphere Reserves comprised of effectively functioning models of sustainable development;
- B. Inclusive, dynamic and results oriented collaboration and networking within the MAB programme and the World Network of Biosphere Reserves;
- C. Effective external partnerships and sufficient and sustainable funding for the MAB programme and the BR Network;
- D. Comprehensive, modern, open and transparent communication, information and data sharing; and
- E. Effective governance of and within the MAB programme and the BR Network.
